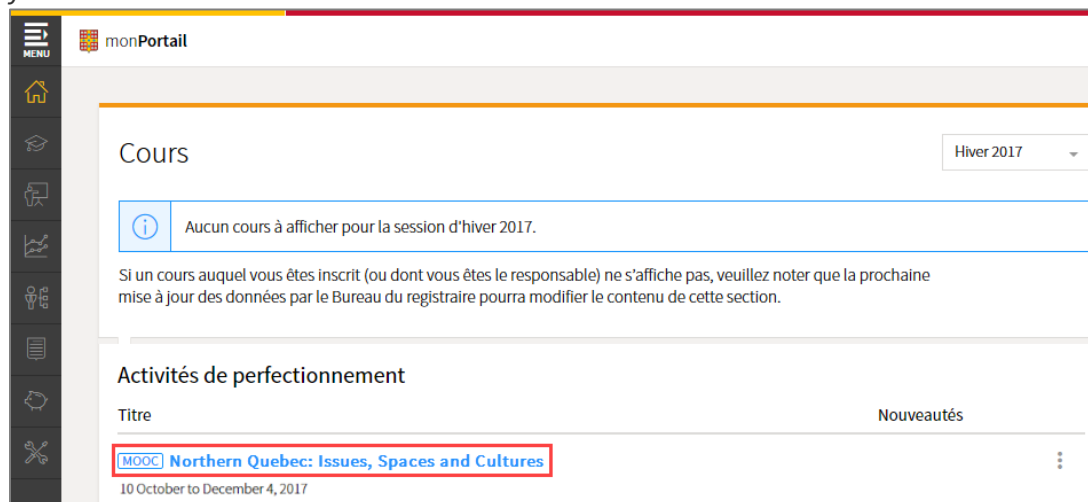

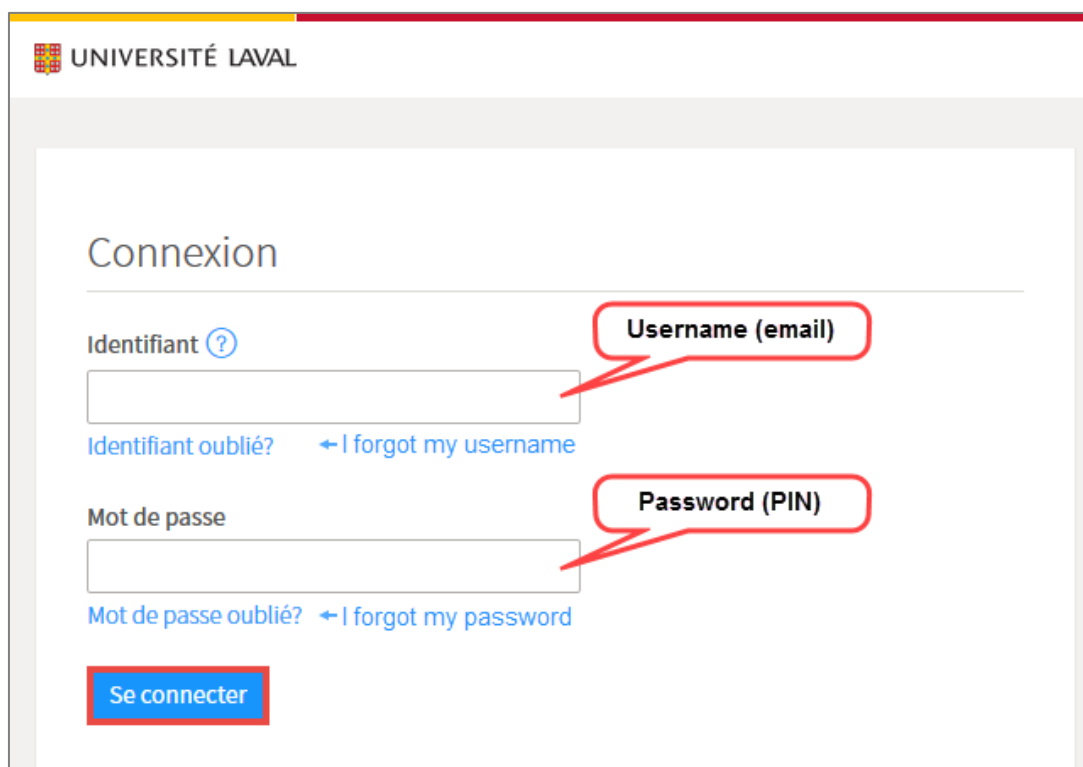

4. In the section **Activités de perfectionnement**, click on the title of the MOOC you want to access.




With a MOOC account
